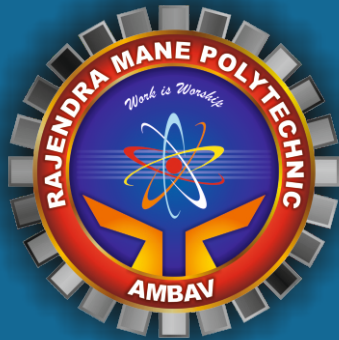

ADMISSION REPORTING PROCEDURE

- After the display of allotment in CAP round or admission in Management Quota, candidate should report to the Institute as per the notified schedule of the admission process.
- Candidate shall report to the Institute with all original certificates needed to substantiate the claim made in the application regarding eligibility and reservation.
- If a candidate is unable to produce original certificate at the time of his/her admission on account of admission already secured to some other Institution, he/she shall produce a certificate from the Head of the Institute where he/she has already taken admission indicating that he/she has been admitted to a particular course in the Institution.
- The candidate shall produce the attested copies of the certificates duly attested by the Head of the respective Institution.
- Such candidates shall be required to pay the fees immediately at the time of admission and shall be permitted to submit the required original certificates within 4 working days after the date of payment of fee.
- After scrutiny of original documents, the candidate will have to pay full fee immediately as prescribed by the Institution and confirm the admission offered.
- If candidate fails to pay the prescribed fee within the reporting time, the candidate forfeits the claim on the allotted seat.
- Admission to backward class candidates will be given on the condition that they submit the Caste Certificate at the time of admission.
- If a candidate is offered admission, his or her original School / College Leaving Certificate (of qualifying examination) will be retained by the Institute. This original certificate will not be returned to any candidate once admitted to a course at the Institute unless the candidate cancels the admission. All other certificates will be verified by the Institute at the time of admission and returned to the candidate after the MSBTE enrolment.
- Admission of Out of Maharashtra State (OMS) students, who have been admitted to any course in the Institution, will be confirmed only on submission of the Provisional Statement of Eligibility from the MSBTE.
- **Cancellation & Refund** : Cancellation of admission and refund is governed by rules laid down by the D.T.E. in their Admission Brochure
- **Concession in Tuition & Other fees** : All the schemes as mentioned in the D.T.E. Admission Brochure.

RMP has a well facilitated and spacious library with more than 6000 technical books, a large collection of National & International Journals, News papers and magazines. Library has digital bar code system.

General :

- Strict silence and discipline to be maintained in the Library.
- Talking or group discussion is not permitted in the Library.
- Use the library books and furniture very carefully.
- Eatables, Audio-Visual device, Mobile phones, and other equipments & their use is strictly prohibited.
- Minimized assignments/ Journals writing in the library.
- Every student entering in the library premises should have a valid college identity card.
- If a student so found without the Identity Card, no library facility for that day will be available to him/her.
- If any reference is required, student should approach the Librarian.
- All cases of disregard of these rules will be reported to the Principal for appropriate action.
- For making the Library Card, two Stamp-size photographs are required.
- Library Cards are non-transferable.
- The holder of the membership card is responsible for the books borrowed by him/her.
- Students can borrow two books for reference purpose against college identity card at a time from the Library.
- The reference books cannot be taken out of Library premises. These reference books must be returned to the library before the close of the library on the same day.



- No books will be reissued without presenting them physically.
- Borrowers may check the books while getting them issued.
- Current periodicals and rare books are to be used in the Library and will not to be issued for external use.
- If mutilated or lost, the borrower will have to replace the book with a new copy or pay the amount of the current price along with the over due charges if any.
- If the membership cards are lost, the Librarian should be informed immediately. In genuine cases a duplicate set may be issued on payment of Rs.10/-. And for that an application should be made to the Principal.
- While taking NOC from library, students are required to submit their library cards to the Circulation counter.
- Students found responsible for any damage caused to the library property will be required to replace the material or pay the price of the property, beside the penalty imposed upon them by the authority.
- If the student is found without an Identity Card, no library facility for that day will be available to him/her.
- At a time 2 books will be issued to student for a period of one week duration.
- If library book is not returned on the schedule day a fine of Rs.10/- per day per book will be charged.
- Pure reference books are only for random reading & not to be issued out.

RULES OF ATTENDANCE

Attendance :

Regarding attendance in theory & practical classes, attention of all the students & their parents / guardians is hereby drawn to the relevant important rules & regulations of MSBTE.

■ Students are required to have at least 75% attendance in the lectures of every subject and 100% Performance in completion of all practicals & term-work.

■ The students who fail to comply the requirements mentioned in (1) above will be detained and hence, not permitted to appear for MSBTE Examinations. Such students also stand to loose one whole year as they will have to seek readmission for the same semester in the succeeding year and repeat it.

The rules & regulations of attendance of MSBTE are binding.

We feel, it is our important duty to appraise the students and their parents/guardians about the necessity of having satisfactory attendance in theory & practical classes and the consequences thereof for non-attendance of these rules & regulations. We also take it as our responsibility to design systems by which the students who are not attending their theory & practical classes are punished.

If any student remains absent continuously for more than three days, he/she will not be allowed to attend lectures/practicals without payment of fine and permission from the Principal on the first three occasions in a semester further to which he/she will not be allowed to the lectures/practicals without being accompanied by his/her parents/guardians. Such irregular students will be punished heavily with fine and/or removal from the college.

For us, as an Institution, the environment and discipline in class & college is very important. The student being a vital component of the Education System - his/her irregularity adversely affects the performance of the system. Therefore, student will be solely responsible for their detention from MSBTE Examinations on account of his / her less attendance in theory/practical classes and unsatisfactory performance in term work assignment, practicals, tutorials, unit test(s) as the case may be.

INSTITUTE RULES & REGULATIONS

1. IT SECURITY POLICY

Applicable to all bonafide Students of the Polytechnic, for use of computing facilities at Polytechnic labs, students should strictly follow the following guidelines.

- No student should try to install any software on any machine within the institute.
- Access of **Orkut & Facebook** is punishable.
- The institute machine in public machine & using it for confidential online transactions is an offence.
- Use of pen drives that may tamper important data in machine is an offence.
- Only safe, secure, authentic & trusted web sites should be accessed.

2. IDENTITY CARD

The Polytechnic will issue a Smart Identity card to every bonafide student. It is mandatory for the students to prominently display the I-card while they are in the college campus.

3. UNIFORM AND DRESS CODE

All students are properly dressed, which is mark of respect to the august place of learning. Any violation will be considered as an act of indiscipline. Students will be advised about formal and dress code from time to time.

4. CODE OF CONDUCT :

- Self Discipline is the best discipline. All students are expected to observe rules and regulations currently in force to enable the smooth working of the Polytechnic.
- In the premises of the Polytechnic, every student must be in clean uniform with prominent display of Identity Card.
- Every student must attend all lectures, practicals, term work and examinations conducted by the Polytechnic.
- As per MSBTE norms, the students appearing for the final examinations should satisfy at least 75% attendance in respective theory lectures, and 100 % in practicals and term work.
- Absence of student on valid grounds at lectures / practicals / term work / examinations must be communicated to the Polytechnic authorities immediately in writing, with the necessary supporting documents viz. medical certificate etc.
- During the conduct of lectures / practicals / term work student should not loiter in and around the Polytechnic premises.
- A student should observe proper decorum in the classes and should take utmost care not to disturb the working of his / her own class as well as other classes.
- Any student disturbing classroom discipline will be suspended from the class with immediate effect and is required to give an undertaking regarding his / her good behaviour in future. If the same misbehaviour is repeated, the student may be expelled from the Polytechnic.

- Every student should take utmost care of the Polytechnic property and try to keep the Polytechnic and its premises neat, clean and tidy. Any Intentional damage done to the Polytechnic building, furniture, equipments by the students shall be treated as breach of discipline and the students will be severely punished. To avoid shame and embarrassment students should refrain from such acts.
- Students should not wear valuable ornaments or carry electronic gadgets including mobile phones etc.
- Students are requested to take care of their personal belongings such as calculator, journals, files, books notes etc. The Polytechnic Authorities will not be held responsible for the loss.
- Every student must preserve original fee receipt (students copy), Identity card and Library card. Loss of the same has to be duly reported to the concerned authorities.
- Students are expected to check up notices being displayed on the respective Notice Boards.
- The students should not use unfair means or any sort of malpractices during examinations conducted either by Polytechnic or by MSBTE. Student, if caught by the supervisor or by examination squad would be liable to strict action, to the extent of being debarred from the examinations.
- The students should not collect any fund from other students or from outsiders without any written permission from the Principal.
- Students should not organize on their own picnic, excursion etc. without prior written permission of the Principal.
- The students should not form society, committee, and organization in the Polytechnic without the sanction of the authorities.
- Students should not invite outsider to address any meeting or to participate in any Polytechnic activities without the prior permission of the Principal.
- Industrial visits and educational tours, as and when arranged by the college, are compulsory for every students. The students shall have to bear the full cost of such visit/ Tours.
- College authorities, under no circumstances shall accept any liability in respect of an accident, which a student may meet with during his/her stay in the college or on an educational visit. The students are therefore, cautioned to conduct themselves in a reasonably careful way whenever they are.
- Government of Maharashtra has notified 'Ragging' as a cognizable offence. Anyone reported to be involved in any form of ragging will be severely dealt with. Therefore, students are required to refrain from indulging in any form of ragging and students should report the incidences of eve teasing Ragging or Harassment by fellow students to the class teacher / HOD / Principal, for immediate actions.
- Use of tobacco, alcohol and smoking within the Polytechnic Premises is strictly prohibited.

HOSTEL RULES & REGULATION

In order to maintain discipline in hostel campus and smooth administration the students are informed to follow the following hostel rules.

1. The students have to stay in their allotted rooms only. Admissions are on first come first serve basis.
2. Guests are not allowed to stay in the hostel without prior written permission from the hostel authorities.
3. No outsider is allowed to stay in the hostel. Any unauthorised stay in the hostel is liable for punishment.
4. To organize any function in the hostel campus, the student should take prior written permission from the hostel authorities. (100 days, Holi, Rangpanchami, Dahihandi, New Year, Birthday etc.)
5. Students are not allowed to keep / use any electrical appliances, Heaters are not allowed in the hostel. If found he / she will be rusticated from hostel
6. Students are not supposed to leave the hostel campus without prior written permission of rector (for ladies hostel timing is 8:15 pm). Students should not remain enter others room during 10:30 pm to 6am.
7. Girl hostelites should be inside the hostel campus before it gets dark in the evening.
8. Boys hostelites should be inside the hostel campus before 7:00 p.m.
9. Playing in the hostel corridor or near by is strictly prohibited, playing any music or creating any sort of noise that will disturb the peace of others is strictly prohibited.
10. Writing & Spitting on the walls and doors of the hostel is strictly prohibited. Rooms, Corridors should be maintained neat & tidy. Any uncleanliness will not be tolerated. If found will be repainted at your cost from all the room mates.
11. No posters are to be pasted on the walls of the hostel/rooms/doors likewise no painting, drawing on the walls/doors is allowed.
12. **No Smoking, No Alcoholic Drinking, No Gambling, No Tobacco Chewing Not Intake Of Banned Drugs** is allowed in the campus. If found in any room all the room members will be rusticated
13. Students are not allowed to keep any weapons with them.
14. No students shall undertake any repair or any damage to the room fittings / furnitures or to carry out any alterations there in.
15. No student shall involve in the theft cases.
16. Ragging is cognizable offence, which can be registered as police complaint, the student found indulging in ragging shall be expelled from the hostel and may be rusticated from the institute.
17. The students are informed that not to waste water & electricity. They are requested to put off electrical switches and taps when they are not in use.
18. A resident student must leave the hostel and give vacant possession of the room to the hostel authorities within three days after the completion of the academic year or university examinations whichever is later. Under no circumstances he / she will be allowed to extend his / her stay in the hostel after above period.
19. All hostelites must use the usual roads for movement. An act of jumping across the compound wall is liable for punishment.
20. No hostelites would leave the premises without the proper permission from the competent authority failing which he / she is liable for removal from the hostel without refund of fee.
21. *STUDENTS INVOLVED IN RAGGING & THEFT CASES WILL BE PUNISHED HEAVILY. STUDENTS INVOLVED IN THESE CASES WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE HOSTEL IMMEDIATELY AND LIKELY TO BE RUSTICATED FROM THE INSTITUTE.



ACTION AGAINST RAGGING

Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999 which is in effect from 15 May 1999 has the following provisions for Action against Ragging.

- a) Ragging within or outside of any educational institution is prohibited.
- b) Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets, or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term up to 2 years and/or penalty which may extend to ten thousand rupees.
- c) Any student convicted of an offence of ragging shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal.
- d) Whenever any student or, as the case may be, the parent or a teacher of an educational institution complains, in writing, of ragging to the head of the educational institution, the head of the educational institution shall, without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, within seven days of the receipt of the complaint, enquire into the matter mentioned in the complaint and if, prima facie, it is found true, suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall, immediately forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the educational institution is situated, for further action. Where, on enquiry by the head of the educational institution, it is found that there is no substance, prima facie, in the complaint received, he/she shall intimate the fact, in writing, to the complainant. The decision of the head of the educational institution shall be final.
- e) If the head of the educational institution fails or neglects to act in the manner specified in section "d" above when a complaint of ragging is made, such person shall be deemed to have abetted the offence and shall, on conviction, be punished as provided for in section "b" above.
- f) Any acts or its amendments which may published from time to time by AICTE, Government or Judgments by Hon. Superme Court of India, Hon. High Court of Bombay, etc. will be applicable to candidates & institutions covered under these rules of admission.
- g) Students/parents are informed to see the copy of AICTE regulations on cubing the menace of raging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 carefully read and fully understand the provisions contained in the said regulations.
- h) Students and parents are suggested to login on www.amanmovement.com for furnishing information about antiragging. The PDF generated after fulfilling required information should be duly signed by both Students and parents and are required to submit to RMP office.

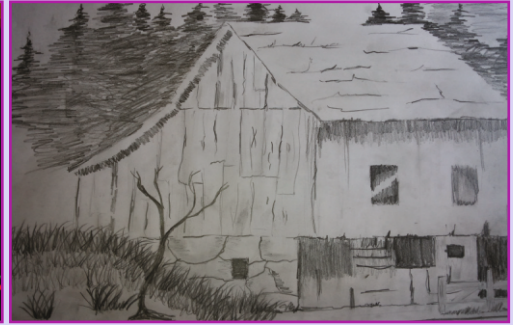

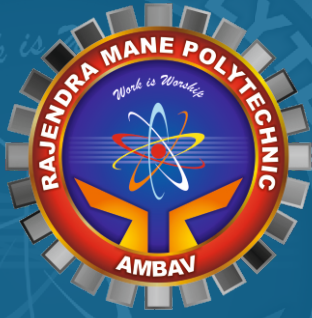
