Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Fees) Act, 2015.

No. TEM-2015/CR 536/TE-4 .— In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) and (2) of Section 3 of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Fees) Act, 2015 (Maharashtra Act. No. XXVIII of 2015), and in supersession of Government Notification, Higher and Technical Education Department, No. MISC.2015/CR No. 252/TE-4, dated 16th June 2015, the Government of Maharashtra hereby, notifies the Full Time Professional Courses mentioned in column (3) of the Schedule A for Diploma Courses, Schedule B for Undergraduate Degree Courses and Schedule C for Post Graduate Degree Courses, as the case may be, of the Schedule appended hereto, for the purpose of Admission to the said Courses.

[the applicant who has passed the qualifying examination (10+2, U.G. & P.G.) in a single sitting examination without having basic qualifications of (10+2+3) is not eligible.]

Further provided that, no candidate from the open University having a degree contrary of the U.G.C. Act and regulations and contrary to Rules of Legal Education shall be eligible.

Further provided that, the candidates who are appearing / appeared for the qualifying examination (regular examination of that academic year) are also eligible to apply for the Entrance Examination. Such candidate become eligible for admission only if they produce the provisional/Degree certificate of the qualifying examination and the mark lists of all parts of qualifying examination at the time of admission.

(c) And obtained score in CET conducted by the Competent Authority.

Explanation— 1: If letter grades are assigned at SSC, HSC, Degree, Diploma or its equivalent examination the candidate must submit the certificate of conversion of letter grades into marks from the competent authority at the time of submission of application form. The Eligibility shall be decided based on the basis of equivalent marks.

Explanation— 2: The Grades or Marks are considered on the basis of which the Class of Degree is awarded by respective University or Board.
